Mode of Content Delivery:

DSU Learning Portal ensures 24/7 access to high-quality digital learning resources with interactive learning support system.

Quadrant	Content Type	Details
Quadrant I	E-Tutorials	Recorded Lecture videos (E-Tutorials) developed using instructional design are used to explain concepts clearly which are accessible easily.
Quadrant II	E-Content	DSU provides Self-explanatory Learning Material, access to e-Library for digital textbooks, articles, case studies, and open education resources.
Quadrant III	Discussion Forums	Asynchronous learning mode is used to provide peer interaction and faculty – student connect for an active and collaborative learning.
Quadrant IV	Self-Assessment	The university follows UGC (ODL Programmes and Online Programmes) Regulations, 2020 for assessments accompanied by solutions and constructive feedback to support your learning.

LMS Access and Learning Support:

- All course components are hosted on DSU Learning Portal with a personalized student dashboard.
- Students can track their academic progress and access e-books, recorded lectures, and assignments at their convenience.
- Interactive support is provided through regular mentor sessions, discussion boards, and faculty Q&A slots.
